For eligibility contact My Aged Care www.myagedcare.gov.au or call the national contact centre on **1800 200 422**.

My Aged Care will ask questions and advise you on the assessment process. Depending on your level of need this is undertaken either by the Regional Assessment Team or the Aged Care Assessment Team.

How much will it cost?

Costs are determined by the program or package of care provided. The cost to you will vary according to your capacity to contribute, determined by the Government.

Our **Dial an Angel** services can be provided to anyone who needs them on a fee paying basis. You may find this option cheaper in the long run.

- 🛀 **Personal care** help with bathing or showering, dressing, hair care etc.

- 👨‍⚕️ **Nursing, allied health and other clinical services** hearing services and vision services.
